Rules & Regulations

1. The organization of the World Championship Youth 2021 has been allotted by the FMJD to the Polish Draughts Federation.

2. General schedule

Sunday, November 28th arriving day

20:00 technical meeting with coaches and chef of delegations

Monday, November 29th opening, 1st round

Sunday, December 5th closing ceremony

Monday, December 6th departure

3. Venue

4. Participants

- a. There will be 8 separate official World Championship Tournaments:
 - Juniors Boys Open (U19) boys born 1st of January 2002 or later.
 - Juniors Girls (U19) girls born 1st of January 2002 or later.
 - Cadets Boys Open (U16) boys born 1st of January 2005 or later.
 - Cadets Girls (U16) girls born 1st of January 2005 or later.
 - Mini Cadets Boys Open (U13) boys born 1st of January 2008 or later.
 - Mini Cadets Girls (U13) players born 1st of January 2008 or later.
 - Hopes Boys Open (U10) boys born 1st of January 2011 or later.
 - Hopes Girls (U10) girls born 1st of January 2011 or later.
- b. Girls are allowed to play in open groups.
- c. Maximal number of players from one country in the same group 4.
- d. Organising federation:
 - Gets one extra place.
 - Can also use a sponsor place. This can be given to another country.



- Can add a player to a group to make even number of players.
- e. Even with special cases (sponsor places, making even etc), the limit of 4 players per country (not valid for the organizing federation) must be respected.

5. Disciplines

- a. Classical draughts games rate: 1h 20' + 1'/move (Fischer)
- b. Blitz games rate: 5' + 3"/move (Fischer)

6. Technical details

- a. number of rounds to be confirmed by the main referee in the technical meeting.
- b. The official software Draughts Arbiter will be used.

7. National team classification.

The national team classification is based on individual results of players representing their national federation.

The best 3 players from one country in the final classification obtain points in each age group, the calculation is done by percentage score + bonus points for top 10 places (bonus points exactly like in World cup: 1° 100, 2° 70, ..., 10° 20). Example - 6 points out of 9 rounds and 21st place gives 33 points for the country. 1st place with 15 points gives 183 points (100+83).

There will be two different classifications in classic and blitz tournament, in each classification results of Boys and Girls groups will be counted together. Hopes groups results will not be counted for National Team Classification.

8. Competition fee

Classic 25 \in , Blitz 10 \in ONLY by electronic payment before November 1st There are two possibilities to pay:

9. Accommodation.

- a. Hotel charges (with breakfast/dinner/supper): 240 € per person (30 € per day).
- b. Free hospitality (paid by organisers) for each 3rd player from the same federation in the group.

Means – *if 1 or 2 players in the group - all must pay; if 3 players in the group, one place is for free.*



c. If federation did not get free places on the condition above - then one player from whole delegation will be for free.

Means – at least one competitor from each federation will receive a free hotel.

- d. If there are 3 players in the same age group from the same country then 1 player gets free hospitality from the organization. If there are 4 players in the same age group, then every of them must pay.
- e. Bank account for electronic payment of the hotel accommodation

f. Accommodation is possible only in the hotel, provided by organizer. Entry to the playing venue is not possible for thus who lives in another places.
